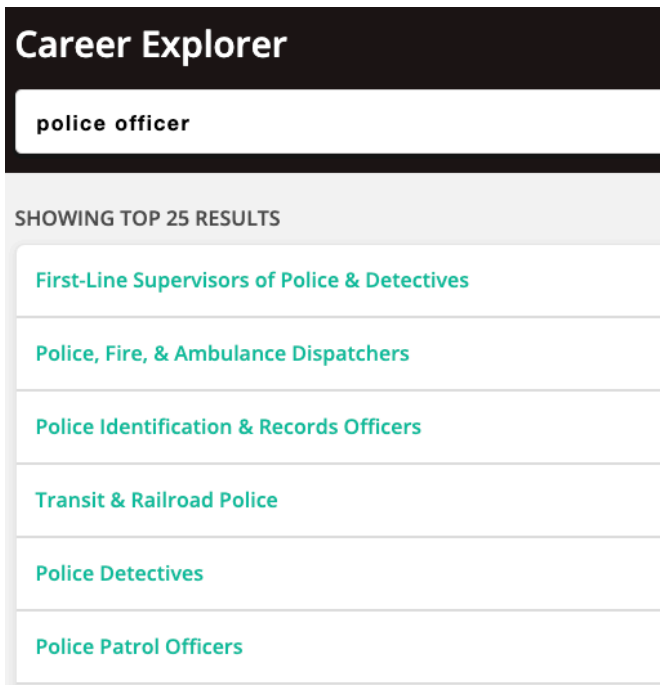
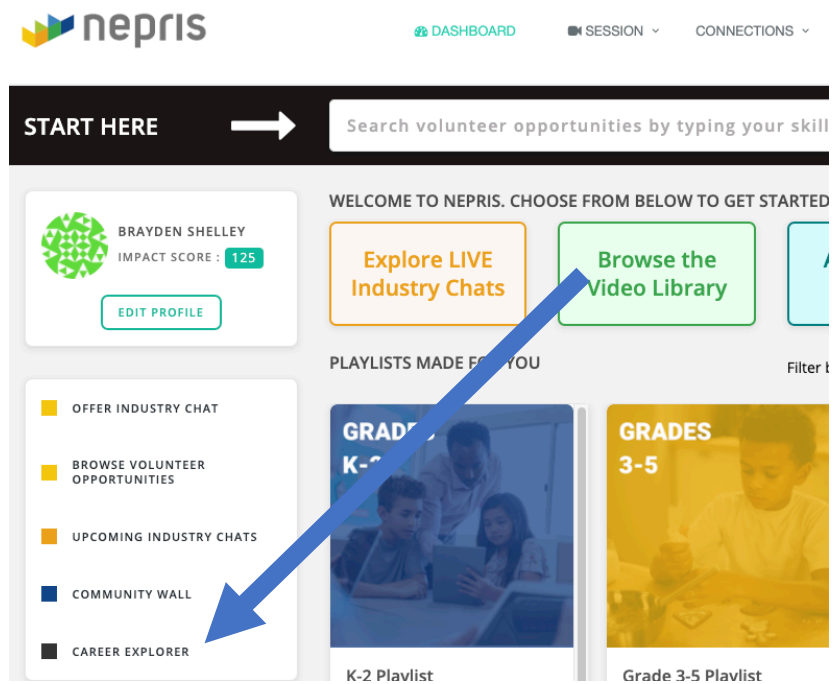


Career Explorer K-2: Community Helpers Lesson

Instructions:

Log in to www.nepris.com and click on Career Explorer on the left menu.



Type the name of a career in the search bar and press Enter. You will then see a list of careers most closely related to the words you searched. Click on the career you want to learn more about.

1. Look at the “What They Need” area. Discuss these skills with your student and how these are important for the job you selected.
2. Look at the “Task” area. Discuss these with your students and how they help people.
3. Scroll to the bottom of the page. There will be videos that are associated with this job. Select a video and watch it with your student. You can also access a playlist of videos about community helpers [here](#).
4. After viewing the video, have the student complete the questions on the activity page.
